Mr. Horn advised that placed on the Council Meeting Agenda is a Resolution to repeal Resolution Number 7-95 which adopted an incentive compensation system for the Director of Food Service at Yankee Trace. This system was too involved. A different and simpler format will be developed.


Mr. Horn advised that Robert Daley asked the City of Centerville for permission to develop an informational video concerning a levy being placed on the election ballot by the Washington-Centerville Public Library Board of Trustees. Council concurred with this proposal.


Mr. Horn outlined information received from Washington Township Administrator Gary Huff relative to the development proposed for the Ratterman Farm. The revised plan could consist of 50 percent single-housing.

Mr. Horn advised that the elevator in the Municipal Building is down and will require between \$30,000.00 to \$35,000.00 to repair. However if unusual sub substances are found the cost could be considerably higher. It will take four to six weeks to repair. The City will request proposals for this project.

Mr. Horn reported that a 30 day extension has been awarded to solicitors in order to obtain additional signatures for the Senate Bill 5 Referendum issue.
