

## ORDINANCE NUMBER 21-01 26.3215 ACRE ANNEXATION

Mr. Horn located a 26.3215 acre parcel of land for which annexation is being sought by the City of Centerville. The subject property was recently acquired by the City of Centerville as a gift from the Dayton Power & Light Company. The property is located west of Yankee Street across from The Golf Club at Yankee Trace. Mr. Horn pointed out that if the property is annexed it will be developed according to City standards and the entire Yankee Street in this location will be within City limits and maintained by the City of Centerville. Dr. Gresham moved that Ordinance Number 21-01, An Ordinance Authorizing the Annexation Of Contiguous Territory Owned By The City Of Centerville And Directing The Municipal Attorney To Prosecute The Proceedings Necessary To Effect Said Annexation, be set for Public Hearing on Monday, July 16, 2001. Mr. Kingseed seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
