Ms. Fackel gave an update on the status of the Court Case involving K & S Enterprises and the City of Centerville concerning the property located at the southwest corner of Wilmington Pike and Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road. The case remains in the Common Pleas Court of Montgomery County.


Mr. Horn reviewed an informational meeting he attended relative to Heartland Airlines hoping to begin operation at the Dayton International Airport. The City of Centerville will soon be asked to support this project along with the City of Dayton. They are looking for EDGE dollars.

Mr. Horn reviewed a meeting he attended relative to the status of 892. Concentration is now on improving I-75 and adding an Austin Road interchange. It is very likely that 892 will never become a reality.

Mr. Horn advised that he along with Steve Feverston and Kelly Fackel met with residents in Rose Estates to discuss the extension of Shawnee Trail to Paragon Road. Residents seemed to be receptive, however they did ask that the roadway not be a straight configuration.

Mr. Horn reported that the Annexation Bill may be put on a fast track for passage in two weeks.
