Mr. Horn reviewed a proposed revision to the Centerville Municipal Code to bring handicap parking requirements in the City of Centerville in conformance with State Law. The proposed changes include the right to tow vehicles that are not properly parked in a handicap zone, and that new handicap parking signs and signs needing to be replaced in the future clearly outline the penalty provisions of illegal parking in such areas. The Police Department has reviewed a proposed Ordinance to provide for these changes and recommend passage to City Council.

Mr. Horn reviewed a request from John Voss that on-street parking along Loop Road be eliminated. A portion of Loop Road has been designated as a no parking zone. This appears to be an ongoing dispute between two local car dealers. City Staff is currently reviewing this situation to find a resolution to the problem.

Mr. Horn advised that the Montgomery County Sanitary Engineering Department has awarded to AAA Pike Cleaning Corporation the project of manhole rehab in the Greater Moraine-Beavercreek Sewer District. The area involved in the City of Centerville extends from Whipp Road south to I-675 and from State Route 48 east to the area of Iron Horse Park. This work should begin in approximately three to four weeks.

Mr. Cline outlined for Council the recent meeting held by the Task Force to develop a Joint Land Use Comprehensive Plan for Centerville and Washington Township. He distributed to Council proposed Master Plan Goals prepared by Township Planner Dave Douglas. Councilmembers were asked to review these goals and offer comments to Mr. Feverston or Mr. Cline.
