
Mrs. McLaughlin advised that the new Official Zoning Map which is the subject of a Public Hearing during the Council Meeting following this Work Session should be amended by motion of Council to include the rezoning adopted by Ordinance Number 10-99 prior to the passage of the Ordinance adopting the new map.

Mr. Horn reviewed the seven bids received for the Yankee Trace Improvement Yankee Trace Section 22 project. Mr. Weaver outlined past experience with the low bidder Stone Excavating, Inc. and recommended acceptance of said bid.

Mr. Horn identified the need to extend the City's franchise agreement with the Dayton Power & Light Company for natural gas until June 30, 2000. This will provide adequate time for the City to work with both the Dayton Power & Light Company and Indiana Energy, Inc. to negotiate a longer term franchise agreement.

Mr. Horn pointed out that the year end appropriations for 1999 is reduced from the original appropriations due to the fact that monies allocated for the police facility have not been expended and will not be in 1999.
