Mr. Reppert, speaking as Chairman of the Council Streets and Highways Committee, advised that the Committee by a 2-1 vote, will recommend to City Council that Virginia Avenue be extended south from Bristol Drive to Spring Valley Road. This will become an agenda item for the August Council Meeting for a decision of the Council of the whole.

Mr. Horn advised that the evidentiary hearing relative to the vinyl siding issue involving Nevin E. Elliott has been rescheduled in the Common Pleas Court of Montgomery County for July 30, 1998.

Mr. Horn advised that the Hearing requested by the City objecting to the transfer of a Liquor Permit To Soft Rock Café, Inc. has been set for July 1, 1998 to begin at 9:30 A.M. in the Montgomery County Administration Building, 451 West Third Street, 7th floor Conference Room.

Mr. Horn recommended to Council that Page 6 of the Lifestyle Ordinance be changed to read as follows: The percentage of detached housing units shall at no time during the construction of the Lifestyle Community be less than 50% of all platted, single-family lots and unplatted housing units constructed or under construction. Mr. Horn distributed to Council and reviewed possible development options for consideration between the City and Great Traditions Land Development, Inc. relative to Yankee Trace.
