

Mr. Stone moved that Council convene into Executive Session to consider the purchase and sale of real property. Mr. Kingseed seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion. Consultant Frank Leone was present at this meeting to discuss negotiations between the City of Centerville and Great Traditions Land and Development Company.

Mr. Horn reviewed efforts being made to secure adequate financial support to bring the NIKE golf tournament to The Golf Club at Yankee Trace. The majority of Council encouraged Mr. Horn to continue in this effort.

As proposed in a memo Mr. Horn recently provided Council relative to incentive proposals at Yankee Trace, Council concurred that Director of Food Service Steve Shaw be remitted one-third of the ice carving revenue produced by him as additional compensation.

Following discussion relative to the 1999 budget for the Centerville Washington Township Historical Commission, Council concurred that each entity budget \$60,000.00 for a total of \$120,000.00.
