## RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-97 DESARO ANNEXATION SERVICES

Mr. Horn reviewed a proposed Resolution in support of the annexation of 4.273 acres of land owned by Joseph and Mary DeSaro, property located east of Yankee Street, extending north from property owned by the Yankee Development Group to Spring Valley Road. The City commits to providing a superior level of services to this territory proposed for annexation. Mr. Singer sponsored Resolution Number 1-97, A Resolution In Support Of The Proposed Annexation Of Property Containing 4.274 Acres More Or Less From Washington Township, Montgomery County, Ohio To The City Of Centerville, Montgomery County, Ohio Pursuant To The Requirements of Revised Code Section 709.031 (B) Ohio Revised Code, and moved that it be passed. Mr. Reppert seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. David Lee, 9073 Academy View Court, was present at this meeting to propose the establishment of a joint governmental task force to address the problem with air noise over the Centerville/Washington Township community caused by fly overs by Airborne Express. Mayor Beals advised that the City and Washington Township will meet jointly on Monday, January 27, 1997, at which time the establishment of a task force can be discussed, however, appointments will have to be made by each individual entity following that meeting. Dr. Lee outlined thirteen objectives to be considered by the task force. He advised that he has submitted petitions to Representative Tony Hall's Office containing 655 signatures.
