Mr. Horn distributed to members of Council draft annexation legislation prepared by the Ohio Municipal League.

Mr. Horn explained the implementation of a soft spike, no spike policy in lieu of metal spikes on The Golf Club at Yankee Trace. The replacement of soft spikes will be available to golfers free of charge every Saturday during the months of February and March at Yankee Trace. After that time there will be a charge of \$4.00.

Mr. Horn advised that the Mayors and Managers Association has selected seven members of the Association to serve on a committee to evaluate public financing options and make recommendations relative to the issue of bringing minor league baseball to the Miami Valley. Mr. Horn has been appointed to serve on said committee. Discussion followed relative to the pros and cons of using private and/or public monies for this purpose. The general consensus of Council was that private revenue be researched; however, if private monies are not available the use of EDGE monies be considered.
