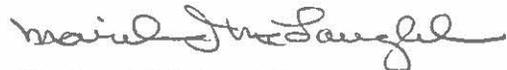
Mr. Horn outlined items he planned to mention during the Council Meeting following this Work Session.

Mr. Horn reviewed the status of improvements to be completed by the developer in Nestle Creek II before Performance Bonds are released. He advised that all but sidewalks have been completed in Nestle Creek III. These sidewalks will be put in place by the builder when homes are built on the subject lot. He recommended release of the Letters of Credit posted on Nestle Creek III subject to the posting of a Maintenance Bond.

Mr. Horn advised that information concerning Great Traditions Land and Development Group and Yankee Trace Development has been received and is currently being reviewed by Real Estate Consultant Doug Harnish.

Upon question of Mr. Reppert, Mr. Horn outlined recent communications with Daniel Doepke relative to the restoration of the building located at the southwest corner of Main and Franklin Streets. Mr. Doepke has asked for more flexibility in the use of loaned money for restoration of the interior and exterior of the building.

While reviewing an Ordinance to provide for additional regulations relating to certain buildings, Mr. Singer brought attention to the need for a clearer definition for Live Entertainment Occupancies and for the intensity of lighting. These items will be further discussed with Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar and changes made to the Ordinance if deemed to be minor amendments.
