



State Senator Charles Horn was present at this meeting to discuss with Council several issues presently before the State Legislature. Mayor Beals and various members of Council outlined reasons for Centerville's opposition to HB36, and why annexation is a significant and vital issue for the City of Centerville.

Mayor Beals distributed to members of Council a draft of a letter addressed to the Main Street Committee relative to the status of the proposed parking lot on the northwest quadrant of the Architectural Preservation District. She asked for comments prior to the letter being sent.

Mr. Horn reviewed the City Planning Commission meeting held on Tuesday, April 9, 1996 at which time the Planning Commission Special Approval Application submitted for the expansion and renovation of Tower Heights Middle School, 195 North Johanna Drive, was referred to City Council for action. This matter will be reviewed by Council during the Work Session scheduled for Monday, April 22, 1996 and will be an agenda item for the May 6, 1996 Council Meeting.
