ORDINANCE NUMBER 12-94 SOUTH MAIN STREET

Mr. Beasley moved that Ordinance Number 12-94, An Ordinance To Appropriate Certain Real Estate Of Jack Fritzche For The Reconstruction And Widening Of South Main Street In The City Of Centerville, Ohio, be removed from the table. Mrs. Beals seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote. Mr. Horn advised that a right of entry has been received from Mr. Fritzche and negotiations continue for the purchase of the right-of-way from Mr. Fritzche necessary for the widening and reconstruction of South Main Street in the City of Centerville. Mr. Beasley moved that Ordinance Number 12-94 be tabled indefinitely. Mrs. Beals seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

1995 TAX BUDGET
