## CENTERVILLE CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION MEETING JANUARY 3, 1994

Mr. Horn reviewed conversations he has had with food services provided in restaurants and clubs in comparison with proposed food service for the Yankee Trace Clubhouse: what seems to work and what does not work. Feedback being received indicates the need to concentrate strictly on food for golfers for lunch and in the evening and the banquet facility, and to forget the fine dining restaurant. He emphasized the fact that even with golf grill and the banquet facility, the City will have to subsidize nothing less than \$46,000.00 annually. He reviewed various options for Council's further consideration relative to the type of Clubhouse that should be provided at the Yankee Trace Golf Course. This matter will be discussed at the Council Retreat scheduled for January 7 and 8, 1994 at which time a decision will be pursued.

Questions, answers and comparisons were considered relative to the City's Waste Collection service and the same in/by other entities. Discussion followed relative to quality of service and rates in these comparisons. Suggestions changes were made to Centerville's Waste Collection service which would perhaps reduce costs in the future. This matter will be further discussed during the Council Retreat.

Mr. Horn gave a brief update on progress being made at the Yankee Trace Golf Course. Work continues on the construction of the maintenance facility, the City has gone to bid for trees, and specifications are being prepared for sand.
