


Discussion followed relative to the 14-2 vote by the Ohio House Elections and Townships Committee for HB30. The bill now goes to the Ohio House Rules Committee. It is important at this immediate time that pressure be placed upon the Rules Committee. Council concurred that Cities represented by members of the Rules Committee be supplied a draft letter and information compiled by Attorney Dick Brahm concerning negatives of HB30. Personal contacts will also be made by members of Council to specified Cities.

Mr. Horn reviewed for Council the City's presentation to be made during the City Planning Commission Public Hearings concerning rezonings relative to land involving the Yankee Trace Golf Course and the City owned property north of existing Social Row Road at Yankee Street.
