Council concurred that the request be honored as specified.


Briefly discussed was a request received from Seniors, Inc. of Centerville/Washington Township that the City contact Senator Charles Horn and Representative Robert Corbin to encourage the awarding of a grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 to help renovate Hithergreen Center. Mr. Kingseed reviewed information he recently received from Representative Corbin that a grant has been awarded to Seniors, Inc. for a lesser amount than the requested \$50,000.00. Council concurred that correspondence from Mayor Shirley Heintz offering Centerville's support be sent to Judith Y. Brachman, Director, Ohio Department on Aging, copied to Jo Ann Ropp, Senator Horn and Representative Corbin.

Mr. Compton entered the meeting at this time.

Mr. Farquhar reviewed for Council a request received from Frank DePalma, Superintendent for the Centerville City School District, that Centerville appoint a Personnel Review Board to hear appeals, terminations and layoffs which may occur in the system. Mr. Farquhar explained the need for the establishment of such a Board. Council concurred that following receipt of a letter of request from Mr. DePalma, a Resolution of intent to establish a Personnel Review Board be prepared for Council's consideration at the next Council Meeting.
