Mr. Horn suggested that Mr. Jim Pierce, Co-Chairman of the Miami Valley Fire (EMS) Regional Cooperative Study Committee, review for Council their report after the Council Meeting scheduled for May 16, 1994.

Mr. Horn advised that Montgomery County Clerk of Courts Craig Zimmers has informed the City of Centerville that the lease will not be renewed for the location of a Deputy Registrar's Office in the building to the rear of the Centerville Municipal Building. The relocation will probably take place on July 1, 1994.

Mr. Horn gave a status report on the construction of the Yankee Trace Golf Course: moved hole number 18 is not yet seeded, work continues on the driving range and the practice holes.

Discussion followed relative to a drainage problem in Nestle Creek upon land owned by Rose Barnes. City Staff has and will be in contact with the developer to determine a solution to the problem.
