
Mayor Heintz outlined for Council her communication with Montgomery County Engineer Rex Dickey relative to Council's recent decision concerning the realignment of existing Social Row Road at the southeast corner of the Yankee Trace Golf Course.

Mayor Heintz suggested that Council consider the appointment of additional members to the Centerville Community Improvement Corporation. Council concurred that early in 1995, a member of the West Milton Community Improvement Corporation be invited to speak with City Council relative to the membership on their Corporation.

Council reviewed Course Rules and Regulations for The Golf Club at Yankee Trace. Following discussion, the majority of Council concurred that Yankee Trace become the home course for the entire golf match play program at the Centerville High School for the year 1995. Its impact will be evaluated prior to 1996. Other areas of concern were expressed relative to the Rules and Regulations and minor changes made. The majority of Council also concurred that Centerville residents and business owners be granted priority starting times eight days in advance.

The Work Session convened into a Council Finance Committee of the whole to review the Budget for the year 1995.
