Mr. Horn briefly reviewed a proposed application for the City of Centerville to execute an Agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to acquire funds through the Transportation Enhancement Program for re-forestation along the Interstate 675 corridor in Centerville and Washington Township. He outlined two options for funding:

1. Federal government funding 80% of the project with the City of Centerville and Washington Township sharing the local share of 20%.
2. Federal government funding 80%, the Ohio Department of Transportation funding 10% with the City of Centerville and Washington Township funding the remaining 10%.


Mr. Hoffman recommended option number 1. Mayor Heintz suggested that mounding be put in place to buffer condominiums from the Interstate while trees are being put in place under this program.

Mr. Horn advised that bids were received and tabulated for the Poinciana Drive improvement. Mr. Hoffman pointed out the fact that the cost of lowering a portion of Poinciana Drive has been reduced due to the fact that Montgomery County has not required the water lines in this area to be lowered.

Council discussed with Attorney Dave Eubank the procedure to follow during the Public Hearing scheduled this date on an Appeal filed by the Centerville United Methodist Church for the demolition of a structure at 59 East Franklin Street in the Architectural Preservation District.

Mr. Horn briefly reviewed for Council his meeting with Golf Course Architect Gene Bates. More information will be forthcoming.
