Mr. Horn briefed City Council on street repair and resurfacing projects currently being done in the City of Centerville under the direction of the Ohio Department of Transportation: Loop Road and State Route 48.

Mr. Horn announced the letting of bids currently underway for the construction of the Yankee Trace Clubhouse.

Mr. Horn reviewed Planning Commission's discussion relative to Centerville's proposed exercise of Three Mile Jurisdiction into Washington Township, at their last meeting. He asked that this matter again be discussed at their July 27, 1993 meeting. Councilmembers had differences of opinion concerning areas in which Centerville should exercise this jurisdiction.

Mr. Horn updated Council concerning activities relative to the construction of the Yankee Trace Golf Course. Irvin Construction has been served with a letter from the City Manager finding them in default of the terms of their Contract, terminating their services for failure to make payments, and giving them seven days to vacate the job site. A meeting has been scheduled with Midwest Golf for Wednesday, July 21, in anticipation of them taking over the construction of the Golf Course with work commencing on Saturday, July 24, 1993.

Mrs. McLaughlin advised that Scot Stone will accept Chairmanship of the Planning Commission, Betty Ann Perkins as Chairman of the Centerville Historical Commission, and Mary Bolton as Chairman of the Centerville Arts Commission.
