Mayor Heintz pointed out the fact that additional interviews for the same purpose will continue on Monday, November 1, 1993. Council concurred that Mr. Evers, Mr. Hoffmann, Mr. Kostak and Mr. Hanna be considered for said appointment at the conclusion of interviews on November 1.

Mr. Horn reviewed for Council a plan for the preparation of the Bicentennial in 1996. The City of Centerville and Washington Township will work jointly in this venture, each appointing ten members to the Bicentennial Committee. Persons interested in serving on the Committee representing the City will be asked to submit their interests to the City Manager. Applicants will then be interviewed by a Interview Committee of three Councilmembers: C. Mark Kingseed, Sally Beals and Brooks Compton. Interviews will be held during the first two weeks in January 1994. Council concurred with the financial plan for the Bicentennial outlined in a memo prepared by Mr. Horn and submitted to Council on October 7, 1993. Mayor Heintz and Township President Terry Blair will sign off on preliminary public notices and the recruitment of volunteer committee members during the next week at the Walton House.

Discussion followed relative to the City's strengths, weaknesses and opportunities identified from the Council Retreat held January 16, 1993. Tentative dates for the next Retreat are January 7 and 8, 1994.
