



Following the Council Finance Committee of the whole, City Council convened into Work Session.

Mr. Horn reviewed financial parameters for consideration in the draft of an agreement between the City of Centerville and Great Traditions for the development of the residential pods in and around the Yankee Trace Golf Course. It appears the best conclusions have been reached between both parties. Discussion followed relative to the future use, the relocation, or the demolition of the home located on the Spires property if said property is purchased by the City of Centerville. The majority of Council concurred that the City make an offer to purchase the Spires property with the understanding that, if the home is relocated or demolished, there could be interference by conforming to the requirements of the Landmark Preservation Ordinance.
