Mr. Kenning announced the loss of an off duty Centerville Police Officer in an auto accident during the past weekend.


Upon question of Mr. Singer, Mr. Kenning clarified the fact that a proposed Resolution relative to retention and/or detention basins for the Iron Horse Park Storm Drainage Project indicates to the Centerville-Washington Park District the City's intention to appropriate certain easements in the Park for this purpose.


Discussion followed relative to a proposed Resolution expressing concern and objections to the Department of Energy's preliminary decision to close the Mound Plant in Miamisburg. Mayor Heintz advised that this Resolution has been requested by Mayor Dick Church of Miamisburg. Upon suggestion of Mr. Kingseed, Section Two of the Resolution was changed as follows:
SECTION 2. The City of Centerville expresses its support for the proposal that an independent commission be created to review the Energy Department's consolidation proposals and future decisions to close Energy Department plants.

Representative Robert Corbin was invited into the Meeting at this time to outline HB 651, the Anti-Annexation Bill which has been referred to the House Elections and Townships Committee.

Following the Regular Meeting, Council reconvened into Work Session in the Law Library with Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar being present. Mr. Kingseed moved that Council convene into Executive Session to consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official of the City of Centerville. Mrs. Beals seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.

After recess of the Executive Session of Council, discussion followed relative to an Annexation Petition soon to be filed with Commissioners of Montgomery County. Filing of this Petition is anticipated on March 17, 1992.
