Bryan Choi and Brian Smith, Architects Associated, were present at this meeting to discuss with Council three floor plan and elevation schemes for the Yankee Trace Clubhouse, two of which were single-story structures and the third a two-story structure. Following discussion on each of the three schemes presented, the majority of Council concurred to move forward with a two-story building but expressed concern with the cost of 2.4 million dollars. Mr. Choi will redesign a two-story floor plan and elevation scheme for Council's consideration during a Work Session scheduled for Tuesday, June 2, 1992, incorporating some concerns expressed by Council during this meeting.

Mr. Haverland reviewed for Council a proposed Resolution required by Bank One authorizing the City Manager to open a Funds Transfer Account with Bank One, Dayton NA. Council concurred that this item be placed on the Council Meeting Agenda following this meeting.

Discussion followed relative to the reappointment of Mr. Scot Stone and Mr. Bernard Samples as members of the City Planning Commission. Mr. Haverland pointed out the fact that if appointments were not made this date, a meeting of the Commission would take place without full membership. The majority of Council concurred that said reappointments be made.
