Chairmanship of the Centerville Arts Commission was briefly discussed by Council. Mayor Heintz pointed out the fact that it was the intent in 1991 that the Chairmanship change on a yearly basis. This matter was delayed until a future Work Session Meeting.

Mr. Haverland reviewed a proposed Resolution through which the City of Centerville gives consent to the Director of Transportation, State of Ohio, to resurface State Route 48 from Edenhurst Road to Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road and State Route 725 from the Centerville Corporation Line to State Route 48. Mr. Hoffman described that area of roadway to be improved.

Mr. Haverland, Mr. Hoffman and Mr. Schwab reviewed for Council a proposed Resolution establishing a procedure for the City to solicit bids for the Construction of the Yankee Trace Golf Course.

Mr. Haverland and Mr. Hoffman outlined for Council the bid submitted by the L. P. Cavett Company for the 1992 street resurfacing program in the City of Centerville in the amount of \$568,735.00. They recommended that the total amount not exceed \$600,000.00 thus providing for some contingencies through the resurfacing process.

Mr. Haverland explained the need for staffing at Benham's Grove for the remainder of 1992: assistance needed for public bookings. Council concurred that this matter be discussed further at the next Council Work Session Meeting. Upon request of Council, Mr. Haverland will submit a job description for the Director of Recreational Services. Discussion followed relative to a proposed Ordinance to amend the Personnel Ordinance making certain provisions for the City Manager. Mr. Farquhar clarified questions of Council relative to this proposed legislation.
