ORDINANCE NUMBER 11-92 CHARTER AMENDMENTS TO ELECTORATE

The Public Hearing was held concerning Ordinance Number 11-92, an Ordinance to submit to the electorate proposed amendments to the Centerville Charter as recommended by the Charter Review Commission. Mr. Haverland briefly reviewed this proposed Ordinance. Upon question of Mr. Beasley, Mrs. McLaughlin advised that said proposed amendments will be included in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Centerville (Centerville-Bellbrook Times) once a week for two consecutive weeks as required by State Law. The amendments will also be included in the next issue of the Town Crier. Mr. Stone sponsored Ordinance Number 11-92, An Ordinance To Provide For An Election On The Adoption Of Amendments To The Centerville Charter For The City Of Centerville, Ohio, As Reported By The Centerville Charter Review Commission And Approved By The City Council, and moved that it be passed. Mr. Compton seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion. Mayor Heintz thanked those volunteers who served on the Charter Review Commission.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned.
