Mr. Kenning updated Council on the Montgomery County EDGE Program. Alternatives continue to be submitted and considered by the Montgomery County Commissioners.

Mr. Kenning briefly outlined the proposed Agreement with Woolpert Consultants for detailed construction drawings for the widening of Wilmington Pike.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Resolution authorizing an Agreement with the State of Ohio for the purpose of maintaining the traffic control signal located at the junction of I-675 and State Route 48, the westbound ramp.

A list of streets in the City of Centerville to be repaired and/or resurfaced in the 1991 Road Improvement Program was distributed to Council by the City Manager.

Mr. Kenning advised that interest at a rate of 4.93% per annum has been received for the Notes in anticipation of Bonds for the purpose of paying part of the cost of acquiring real property for municipal recreational facilities (Centerville Golf Course Project).
