Mr. Kenning reviewed Resolutions on the Council Meeting Agenda to provide for the following:

1. Agreement with the Combined Health District of Montgomery County to establish an alcohol rehabilitation program.
2. Contract with Public Defender Commission to provide for legal counsel to indigent persons.
3. Accepting amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission for fiscal year 1992.

Mr. Kenning brought attention to correspondence received from the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 9550, Centerville, Ohio, proposing that a three foot by five foot "P.O.W./M.I.A." memorial flag be flown daily on the pole in the Leonard E. Stubbs Memorial Park which holds the American flag. This flag would be supplied by the VFW, announcement and presentation to be made on December 7, 1991. Following discussion, Council concurred that this flag be flown during the month of December, 1991 and for special occasions. Plans will be made for the presentation on December 7.

Mr. Kenning reminded City Council of the City/Township Joint Meeting scheduled for Monday, November 25, 1991 to be held at the Washington Township Government Center, meeting to begin at 7:30 PM.

Mr. Singer proposed that Mayor Heintz get some sort of intention from the Centerville/Washington Park District relative to priority number 1 established in the Stormwater Management Master Plan for the implementation of a substantial detention basin in the Iron Horse Park so that the City can proceed with preliminary engineering for this improvement.

Council concurred that the Mayor's Committee to Study Intergovernmental Issues continue to proceed with the circulation of annexation petitions.
