Mr. Farquhar reviewed for Council the status of the following court cases involving the City of Centerville:

A Memorandum in Support of Jurisdiction will be filed by December 13, 1991 relative to the annexation of approximately 466 acres of land in Washington Township to the City of Centerville. Attempts are being made for this matter to be accepted for hearing by the Supreme Court.

Centerville's brief has been filed relative to the Montgomery County EDGE Program. Montgomery County has asked for an expedited hearing on this subject.

Cases involving the appropriation of real property for right-of-way necessary for the reconstruction of East Whipp Road are being resolved.

Mr. Kingseed moved that Council convene into Executive Session to confer with Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar disputes involving the City of Centerville that are the subject of pending or imminent court action. Mr. Compton seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.


Council reconvened into Regular Work Session at this time.

Mr. Kenning brought attention to Section 12.04 Amendments to the Charter, subsection (b) Review, which states that at the first meeting in January, 1992, Council shall appoint a Commission of nine electors of the Municipality to review the existing Charter and make such recommendations as it may see fit for revision. As suggested by Mayor Heintz, Mr. Stone consented to serving on the Commission. Other names will be submitted by Councilmembers for consideration at a future Council Work Session Meeting.

Mr. Compton moved that Council reconvene into Executive Session to consider the compensation of public employees. Mr. Kingseed seconded the motion. A roll call vote resulted in seven ayes in favor of the motion.

Council reconvened into Regular Session and adjourned the Meeting at this time.
