Mr. Farquhar reviewed for Council, State Statutes relative to the merger and formation of Townships.



Oil Company has requested that their Appeal against a decision of the Planning Commission relative to rights-of-way along Wilmington Pike and the proposed extension of Cloyo Road, be tabled until the Council Meeting scheduled for July 16, 1990. The Applicant is near condemnation actions to provide these necessary rights-of-way. B. P. Oil is preparing the condemnation papers and paying the cost for same; the City will purchase the property for \$1.00.
