

Mr. Kenning outlined a proposed grant application by the City of Centerville for submittal to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for the purpose of acquiring funds through the litter prevention and recycling program. The purchase of a recycling truck is proposed if the grant is received.

Mr. Farquhar reported on current litigation concerning the City's recent annexation of approximately 470 acres in Washington Township to the City of Centerville. A ruling on the Appeal is expected in the near future.

Discussion followed relative to the Appeal filed by the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County against a Planning Commission decision denying a Variance Application to locate a second two million gallon water tank at the dead end of Johanna Drive.
