City Council reviewed proposals and interviews held relative to four groups being considered for the development of the Centerville Golf Course. Following discussion, the majority of Council concurred that a Contract be negotiated by Mr. Kenning with the group of Gene Bates and David Jensen.

Discussion followed relative to the Automated Fingerprint Identification System proposed by the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission. This proposal is being offered to Cities and Townships in Montgomery County to participate at a per capita cost of 5.2201. City Council concurred not to participate in this AFIS proposal at this time; Council believes this should be addressed at the state level to satisfy local needs.

Mr. Kenning advised that a second offer to purchase the Austin Road Tennis Barn has been submitted for a purchase price of \$550,000.00. This offer will lapse within the next two days.

Mr. Kenning advised that Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar will meet with Mr. Thomas Stolz to provide for the deeding of the property at 171 West Spring Valley Road to the City of Centerville.

Mayor Heintz reviewed her recent Meeting with Centerville Washington Park District Board Member William Yeck. The Park District is not interested in the creation of a Recreation District.

Mrs. McLaughlin advised that the terms of Janet Thobaben and Winifred Risner will soon expire as Members of the Centerville Historical Commission. They are both interested in serving another term on this Commission. Council concurred with these reappointments. This will be an agenda item for the December 19, 1990 Council Meeting. At this point the Council Finance Committee of the whole met to review the Capital Improvement Program 1991-1995 and the 1991 Budget for the City of Centerville.
