Mr. Kenning advised that Mr. Gene Bates, Golf Course Architect, is in the process of drafting a proposed Contract with the City of Centerville for the development of the golf course project. This draft should be received by the City in approximately one week.

Mr. Kenning briefly reviewed an outline prepared by the Washington Township Administrator Michael Morton and himself for the establishment of a Satellite Juvenile Court. This item was placed on the Agenda for the Council Meeting following this Work Session.

Mr. Kenning reviewed the following Bids received for the rental of uniforms for the Service Department:



Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Contract with the Montgomery County Public Defender Commission for the year 1991. Through this Contract the Commission will provide legal counsel to indigent persons charged with violations of the City's Municipal Ordinances.

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Ordinance to vacate a small amount of right-of-way along existing Whipp Road. This Ordinance is necessary to make a technical correction to Ordinance Number 12-88.

Mr. Kenning recommended tabling the Ordinance to adopt the Municipal Code for the City of Centerville. Some technical changes are necessary prior to its adoption. This is an agenda item for the Council Meeting following this Work Session.
