Mr. Stone, speaking as Chairman of the War Memorial Oversight Committee, announced the dedication of the War Memorial in the Leonard E. Stubbs Memorial Park on Tuesday, July 4, 1989 scheduled for 3:30 P.M., rain or shine.

Mayor Heintz reviewed for Council a recommendation from the Montgomery County District Solid Waste Management Planning Committee that a District Fee for Solid Waste Disposal Planning and Implementation be established, the cost of this to the City of Centerville would be \$1.20 per ton of waste generated in Centerville. Upon request of Mr. Stone, cost figures will be distributed to City Council prior to the passage of a Resolution approving the establishment of this District Fee.

Mr. Kenning briefly reviewed the Bids received for the purchase of one satellite side load refuse packer for the City of Centerville. He recommended acceptance of the Bid received from Midwest Epoke for a TR31403 GMC refuse packer in the amount of \$31,994.00
