Mr. Kenning advised that the new facilities for the License Bureau in the building located behind the Centerville Municipal Building, are anticipated to open on Thursday, July 20, 1989. The fees generated will pay for the improvement in approximately two years.

Mr. Farquhar advised that Mill End Draperies, property included in the South Main Street/Spring Valley Road Improvement Project, will be signing an Offer to Sell Real Property needed for right of way purposes. The Resolution authorizing this purchase has been placed on the Council Meeting Agenda following this Work Session.

Discussion followed relative to a Resolution approving the establishment of a District Fee for Solid Waste Disposal Planning and Implementation as recommended by the Montgomery County Solid Waste Management Planning Committee. The majority of Council did not agree with the costs established and requested additional information before passage of this Resolution.

Council concurred with the proposed Ordinance to establish a Centerville Historical Commission.
