Mr. Kenning distributed to City Council a draft for a "Request For Proposal" (RFP) for consulting services for the development of the City's Storm Water Drainage Master Plan.

Mr. Kenning advised that assistance from the Federal Government has failed concerning flood damage that occurred this past spring. Their opinion is that the approximate \$4 million dollar loss should be handled by the State.

Council briefly discussed Bids received for Black Oak Storm Sewer Improvements 1989, Centerville-Traffic Signal Improvements 1989 and Centerville Road Improvements 1989.

Mayor Heintz advised that the Centerville Kiwanis does not intend to continue alone the organization of activities for the Americana Festival. Council concurred that Mr. James Reppert and Mr. Joe Bowlus be invited to the next Council Work Session Meeting to discuss the future of the Americana Festival.

Upon suggestion of Mr. Haverland, the signing of the Ordinance creating the Historical Commission will be performed at the Walton House. Mr. Samples will be the Council Liaison to this Commission.
