



Mr. Kenning reviewed with Council a letter received from Washington Township asking that the City negotiate with property owners for the installation of sidewalks along the east side of Marshall Road while the roadway is improved by Washington Township. Mr. Kenning pointed out the fact that the portion of land along the east side of Marshall Road upon which sidewalks will be installed is in Washington Township, thus he suggested that the entire project be negotiated by the Township. Council concurred with Mr. Kenning's proposal.

Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council communications received from Attorney Timothy Tye concerning the establishment of an upscale restaurant in Williamsburg South, proposed to be located on the east side of State Route 48 approximately across from the Elder-Beerman Store. The majority of Council concurred that Mr. Kenning proceed with Mr. Tye's proposal.
