RESOLUTION NUMBER 19-88 WHIPP ROAD REALIGNMENT

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Resolution ratifying his action taken to execute an Agreement between the Greene County Commissioners, the City of Kettering and the City of Centerville in order to obligate payment of costs incurred with the realignment and improvements to Whipp Road at Wilmington Pike, those costs within their respective boundaries. Mr. Compton sponsored Resolution Number 19-88, A Resolution Ratifying The Action Taken By The City Manager To Enter Into An Agreement By And Among The Board Of County Commissioners, Greene County, The Council Of The City Of Kettering, And The Council Of The City Of Centerville, Obligating Payment Of Their Share For Certain Improvements To Whipp Road, and moved that it be passed.
