

Mrs. McLaughlin advised that the terms of Elmer Tate and Marian Simmons as Members of the Planning Commission will soon expire. Both have indicated a desire to be reappointment to their positions. Council concurred with said appointments.

Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council the request for Hospital Revenue Bonds submitted by Lutheran Social Services of the Miami Valley for Bethany Lutheran Village. He pointed out the fact that the Bonds do not and shall not represent or constitute a debt or pledge of the faith and credit of the City of Centerville. Mr. Farquhar identified this as an extension or renewal of previous Bonds issued by the City of Centerville several years ago for Bethany Lutheran Village.

Council briefly discussed the Bikeway in Centerville proposed by the Mayor's Bikeway Committee in 1986. Upon question of Mrs. Beals, Mr. Kenning advised that it is legal to ride a bicycle on sidewalks, provided that the bicycler yields to pedestrians and small children.
