Mr. Stone reviewed the plans being made by the Sister City Committee for the visitors from Bad Zwischenahn, West Germany and Waterloo, Ontario, Canada.

Mr. King briefly reviewed a proposed Resolution reallocating Income Tax receipts to various funds beginning June 1, 1988. This is a yearly procedure to adjust monies into proper City funds.


Mr. King briefly reviewed the proposed tax budget for the City of Centerville for the next fiscal year ending December 31, 1989. After approval by City Council, this Budget will be submitted to the Budget Commission of Montgomery County.

Mr. King advised that a request has been received from Attorney Barry Mancz for an extension of the Subdividers Agreement on Thomas Paine Settlement Number Three - Clyo Road, for an additional six months. Council concurred with this request.

Mr. King reviewed for Council a recommendation received from the City Engineer that the Sidewalk Bond posted for Walnut Hills Estates II, Section 2 be reduced from \$12,000.00 to \$2,800.00. All sidewalk has been installed except for that section in front of one undeveloped lot; \$2,800.00 will cover that cost. Council concurred with said reduction.

Mayor Heintz brought attention to a property maintenance problem existing at 35 Weller Avenue in the City of Centerville. Problems of this type will be further discussed by Council.
