Mr. Kenning advised that the Consultants developing the Streetscape and Transportation Plans for the Architectural Preservation District have met with City Staff. The Consultants will meet with City Council on Monday, August 29, 1988 to receive feedback from City Officials. The Architectural Preservation District Task Force will be reactivated at a later date to serve as a sounding Board for the Consultants.

Mr. Kenning advised that the State of Ohio License Bureau is now selling auto license plates in the building to the rear of the Centerville Municipal Building.
