Mr. Kenning reviewed the following Bids received for the rental of uniforms to be used by the Service Department of the City of Centerville, for a two year period:

Arrow Uniform Rental Dayton, Ohio	\$12,542.00
Domestic Linen & Supply Company Vandalia, Ohio	14,364.40
Aratex Services, Inc. Dayton, Ohio	12,721.10

He recommended that the Bid submitted by Aratex Services, Inc. in the amount of \$12,721.10 be accepted, in consideration of the fact that Aratex maintains local service facilities while the other two Bidders ship uniforms to Michigan for service and repair. Mayor Heintz emphasized the need for employees handling waste to wear gloves and suggested that seasonal workers in the Service Department be furnished uniforms during their employment with the City.

The Appeal filed by Tifton Greens against a decision rendered by the Planning Commission during their Meeting on August 30, 1988, denying their Variance Application to permit solid fences in excess of the permitted height in designated areas and the erection of an additional ground mounted sign, was again discussed by Council. The suggestion was made that mounting be provided in front of the fence bordering Clio Road high enough to de-emphasize the fence. Landscaping could also be put in place in the fenced areas.
