Council briefly discussed the Appeal filed by Ashland Oil, Inc. against a decision rendered by the Planning Commission during their Meeting on January 13, 1987 relative to a Variance Application for the property located at 113 North Main Street in the Architectural Preservation District. The Planning Commission denied two Variances requested: 1. rear and side yard parking, and 2. signage for a total of 64 square feet.

Mr. Kenning advised that no additional information has been received from Swartzel/Affiliated Insurance Service concerning package insurance coverage for the City of Centerville.

Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council proposed improvements to the intersection of State Route 725 and Wilmington Pike; improvements which will form a clean T at the intersection. It is appropriate at this time to pursue acquisition of necessary right-of-way at the northwest corner. Council concurred with Mr. Kenning's proposal.

Mayor Heintz announced the fact that Centerville has been designated as Tree City U.S.A.
