Alleged activities at a Centerville Business were discussed by Council. This matter will be further reviewed by Mr. Kenning.

Mr. Kenning reviewed with Council a letter received from Municipal Attorney Robert Farquhar relative to the City's establishment of a Civil Service Commission and to certify payroll for the Centerville City School District. Mr. Kenning will further review this matter with the Municipal Attorney.

Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council 1986 ending balances, encumbrances and unencumbered balances, and defined differences.

Discussion followed relative to better liaison between the City of Centerville and local businesses. Mr. Taylor suggested that somewhat of a structured program be developed, and that small areas of the business community be invited to participate in this program at City hall. This would provide an update and exchange of information between business and local government. Mr. Singer emphasized the importance of City Officials visiting the larger businesses periodically. Council concurred that meetings be scheduled between City Officials and the business community on a bi-monthly basis, staggering locations (one month at City Building, one month at a business establishment), and that the meetings at City hall be structured to a point.

Council discussed the South Metro Chamber of Commerce and what the Chamber could do for the City of Centerville.

Mr. Kenning reported that sidewalk replacement has begun in Rose Estates.

Mayor Heintz stressed the need for the location of a drop-off area at the Centerville Branch of the United State Post Office. This matter will be pursued by the City Manager.
