Total Office Products	8,300.00


Mr. Kenning recommended acceptance of the low and best bid submitted by Remco Office System in the amount of \$7,999.95.

Mr. Kenning advised that contacts continue to be made by City Staff with local and state health departments relative to the existing bird problem in the City of Centerville.

Upon question of Mayor Heintz, Mr. Kenning explained that curb and gutter was not included in the State Route 48/Clyo Road improvement project due to the fact that engineering for this project took place several years ago when safety was the primary concern.
