



Mr. King reviewed for Council the sunset provision in the Keg Ordinance, which necessitates the reenactment of this Ordinance if it is the intent of Council to retain this provision in the Centerville Municipal Code. He brought attention to a memo prepared by the Chief of Police endorsing the reenactment of the Keg Ordinance.

Mr. King outlined for Council information he received relative to the control of starlings in Laurel, Maryland through the use of fiberglass owls. Mayor Heintz suggested that this information be supplied to residents of Centerville so that they may deal with this problem as they wish. Mr. King will bring the starling problem to the attention of the Federal Government; the situation has worsened with the construction of I-675. The Petitioners will be supplied a packet of information and will be informed of action taken by the City.
