



Mr. Kenning reviewed for Council a proposal prepared by Service Director Richard Bishop relative to the collection of coats from Centerville residents. A project has been developed by Carl Nichols, Channel 2, to collect coats for needy kids, referred to as "Carl's Coats for Kids". This program is scheduled to last through the month of October. Mr. Bishop proposes to collect donated coats from residents on their regular trash day, clearly marked and wrapped in a plastic bag. Centerville's participation in this program could be promoted by Carl Nichols on T.V. City Council concurred with Mr. Bishop's proposal.

Mayor Heintz advised that she had been contacted by Mr. Kevin Carver, Montgomery County, relative to Centerville's participation in the Community Development Block Grant Program. Discussion followed relative to the City's participation in this program for 1988. Council concurred that Montgomery County be invited to the next Council Work Session Meeting to outline benefits to the City through such an Agreement.
