Mrs. Ferne Reilich, Member of the Sister City Committee, was present to discuss with Council the possibility of a Sister City trip to Bad Zwischenahn in West Germany. Through discussion, it became apparent that this would not be workable for 1985 but perhaps should be considered for 1986.

Mrs. McLaughlin advised that an Application has been received from Denise Siler for appointment to the Board of Architectural Review for the City of Centerville. Council concurred that said appointment be made. This will be an agenda item for the February 17, 1986 Council Meeting.

Mr. Kenning announced the resignation of Assistant City Manager Jon Bormet effective March 3, 1986. Mr. Bormet has been hired as City Manager of Montgomery, Ohio.

Mr. Kenning advised that plans have been coordinated between all entities involved if a teacher's strike becomes a reality in Centerville.

Mrs. Heintz announced the Joint Meeting scheduled between the Centerville City Council, the Washington Township Trustees and the Centerville School Board, for Monday, March 31, 1986.

Resulting from Joint Fire District discussion, Mr. Kenning will draft a report for review at a later date.

Mrs. Heintz reviewed the possibility of the Wright House being used as a museum by an association of aviation women. information will be forthcoming following on-site inspection by a member of the association.

Following discussion, Council concurred that awards be given in the future recognizing outstanding building improvement in the City of Centerville. These will be considered on a one by one basis.

Mr. Kenning announced the fact that a Community Blood Bank is being established for employees of the City of Centerville, details will follow at a later date.

At this time, a Streets and Highways Council Committee Meeting was called, with all of the above listed Members of Council and City Staff attending, to reviewed the proposed 1986 Street Improvement Program. Mr. Bormet reviewed the Program in the amount of \$350,000.00 allocated as follows:

Concrete street repair \$194,400.00
Asphalt street repair 93,250.00
Special projects 24,000.00

Reserve for additional

projects throughout program 38,350.00

Council will bring to the attention of City Staff areas needing repair which are not listed in the Program.

Mr. Siler brought attention to a left turn problem from Elwood Drive onto State Route 48 during peak hours of the day. This matter will be reviewed by Mr. Kenning for improvement.
