

In consideration of the Conditional Use Request filed by Hills Developers, Inc. to develop a residential multi-family condominium project at the northwest corner of Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road and Bigger Road, the ratio of single-family to multi-family units in Centerville was discussed by Council.


Mr. Kenning extended to Councilmembers an invitation to attend the Work Session being held by the Cable Operations Board on August 20, 1986 to discuss 1987 work program and budget preparation.

Mr. Kenning advised that the temporary restraining order existing on the installation of the walkway easement in Walnut Hills Estates has been dissolved, the case will eventually be heard on its own merits.

Mayor Heintz reviewed a proposal from Mary Slicer, a Centerville resident, to provide 1987 calendars, drawings, and note cards featuring the City of Centerville. Mrs. Slicer also proposed the development of a historical district poster at a cost of between \$1500.00 and \$1800.00.
