Held January 7, 19 85

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1-85 PERS/PPF

Mr. Kenning reviewed a proposed Ordinance to amend Ordinances 44-84 and 45-84 which provided that the City of Centerville pay six of the eight percent mandatory employee retirement contributions to the Public Employees' Retirement System and the Police and Firemen's Disability and Pension Fund. This Ordinance provides language to comply with the Internal Revenue Service requirement. Other very minor changes have been made to clarify Ordinances 44-84 and 45-84. Mr. Taylor sponsored Ordinance Number 1-85, An Emergency Ordinance Amending Ordinances 44-84 And 45-84 By Amending The Effective Date Said Ordinance Commences And By Placing Additional Restrictions On The Plan Established By Said Ordinances, and moved that it be passed. Mr. Siler seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote of Council.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2-85 PERS/PPF

Mr. Siler moved that Ordinance Number 2-85, An Ordinance Amending Ordinances 44-84 And 45-84 By Amending The Effective Date Said Ordinance Commences And By Placing Additional Restrictions On The Plan Established By Said Ordinances, be set for Public Hearing on January 21, 1985. Mr. Singer seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
