ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-85 ZONING ORDINANCE OXFORD REZONING

Due to a fault in the Legal Notice, caused by the Times Publications, it was necessary to reset the Public Hearing to be held on Ordinance Number 10-85. Mr. Stone moved that Ordinance Number 10-85, An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 15 Dated December 11, 1961, The Zoning Ordinance By Rezoning 67.773 Acres More Or Less, From Centerville Light Industry Classification To Centerville Entrance Corridor Classification, be set for Public Hearing on September 9, 1985. Mr. Siler seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

OXFORD DEVELOPMENT CONDITIONAL USE REQUEST

Mr. Compton moved that the Conditional Use Request submitted by Oxford Development Enterprises, Inc., to develop a 358 unit adult apartment complex along the west side of proposed northern extension of Clyo Road, be reset for Public Hearing on September 9, 1985. Mr. Samples seconded the motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote of City Council.
